



CONNECTING THE LETTERS



Supplies:

- Butcher's or Art Paper
- Assortment of Coloured Markers

1. On a large sheet of butcher's paper or art paper, write pairs of letters ensuring to spread them out.
2. Choose a letter to start with and ask your child to find its match and draw a line to connect them together.
3. Repeat with all the pairs of letters.

Tips:

We would highly recommend using washable markers as it can be easily wiped off with baby wipes in case, they go off the paper.

Narrating

the letters as they are matching it up can be a great help to develop their sense of confidence, "You found the letter A, can you find the other letter A that matches it?".
